Junior League 2019/20 - Rules

All players must be affiliated to England Netball to be able to play in the Frome Junior League.

All teams enter at their own risk. Please ensure that all players, officials and parents adhere to the England Netball Codes of Conducts.

All teams must arrive 15 minutes before their match is due to start.

MATCH FEES - £ 10.00 per day and must be placed in an envelope clearly marked with **DATE & TEAM NAME** and handed into a Frome Official before playing. All matches must be paid for, even if not played. Or you can pay direct into the club's bank account.

TEAM SHEET - Please ensure you complete your team sheet including photo/video consent for each player and hand in before you start your first match.

All matches will be played at **Oakfield Academy, Oakfield Road, Frome, BA11 4JF between 10am – 4pm**. If matches are on both courts there will be a central timer. Please arrive on time to start your match as otherwise the game will start without you on court.

All teams must have a match ball, a set of bibs.

All teams must have access to a first aid kit during matches and have a nominated primary carer for each match.

All teams must provide a competent umpire and scorer for each match.

Please note that players are allowed to play up, but not down!

Fixtures will be issued during August. Match length will depend on how many team entries per age category.

Before the start of each match umpires must collect a scorecard and hand to their designated scorer. The first named team on the scorecard will take the first centre pass. At the end of the match both umpires are to sign the scorecards and also write the Player of the Match for each team, then return scorecards to the central gazebo set up in the middle of the 2 courts.

No jewellery of any type to be worn and nails must be trimmed short and neat with no sharp edges, they will be checked prior to each match.

If you cannot make a league day/fixture for any reason, please inform Andrea McCall asap, any games missed you will forfeit and points will be awarded to the other team.

If for any reason we have to cancel any matches due to bad weather or unforeseen circumstances we will inform you by 8:00am on the day. Please note matches will not be re-arranged due to non-attendance you will forfeit this match and points will be awarded to the other team. The cancelling team will still be liable to pay the match fee of £10.00.

The **reserve dates** on the fixture list should be kept free by all teams in case of cancellations due to bad weather etc.

Points will be allocated on the following basis: 5 points for a win, 3 points for a draw, 2 points to the losing team if their score is within 5 goals difference (inclusive) of the winning team's score and 1 point to the losing team if their score is within 50% (inclusive) of the winning team's score.

Unacceptable behaviour towards other players or umpires will not be tolerated. Any incidents need to be reported in writing to June Barnes the Chair and will be dealt with promptly. If the Committee deem the behaviour to be unacceptable your team will be instantly disqualified.
